



## Parent/Guardian Consent Form for Accompanying Children

Participants must be at least 18 years old (as of 30 June 2013) to attend the conference on his/her own. Children/youth under the age of 18 (as of 30 June 2013) must be registered as an accompanying child and must therefore be accompanied by an adult (18 years old as of 30 June 2013) who is registered for the conference in order to attend. ### Conference Overview

The conference is a unique opportunity for the world's leaders to examine the latest developments in HIV-related research, and to explore how scientific advances can – in very practical ways – inform the global response to HIV. The conference sessions are organized into four tracks: Basic Sciences, Clinical Sciences, Prevention Science, and Operations and Implementation Research. The scientific programme aims to provide new insights into HIV disease development, biomedical prevention, clinical care that can lead to novel research directions and help translate theoretical advances into clinical and prevention practice while building evidence for successful programme operations and implementation.

A lounge for people living with HIV ("Positive Lounge") will be available onsite. The Positive Lounge will be a place of rest and support where there will be complimentary snacks, spaces for informal meetings and relaxation and private facilities for taking medication. Exhibit areas with education displays and presentations will include content on human sexuality, sexual and reproductive health including condoms, female condoms, homosexuality, drug use and paraphernalia. There will be displays by pharmaceuticals promoting their products including HIV medications.
